- (a) Five Trustees shall form a quorum for a meeting of the Trustees.
- (b) All matters will be decided mutually by the Trustee.
- (c) Resolution passed without any meeting of the Trustees but by circulation thereof and evidenced in writing under the hands of two thirds of the trustees shall be as valid and effectual as a Resolution duly passed at a meeting of Trustees.
- 15. The Trustees shall have the power to determine in case of doubt whether any money or property shall for the purpose of the charity be considered as capital or income and whether out of income or capital any expenses or outgoing ought to be paid or borne and every such determination shall be binding and conclusive provided that nothing contained shall be deemed to authorise the Trustees to spend the income or corpus of the Trust for any purpose not authorised by these presents.

16. Maintenance of Books of Accounts:

Regular books of accounts of the Trust shall be maintained incorporating all the revenue and expenditure and such books shall be closed once every 31st March. The same shall be got audited by a Chartered Accountant appointed or reappointed every year and the necessary returns shall be filed with the authorities.

- 18. It is expressly declared that no part of the Trust property or its income or any accretion thereto shall be applied for any purpose outside India or for any purpose which is not a charitable purpose in law, and all provisions hereof shall be construed accordingly.

- Two-thirds majority shall constitute the office of the Trust at Patna unless changed by the Trustees.

21. POWER & FUNCTION OF THE OFFICE BEARER

MANAGING TRUSTEE:

The Managing Trustee shall preside at all meetings of the trust, when he is present and shall exercise such other powers as are conferred upon him by these rules. The Managing Trustee may call for an emergency meeting through Managing Trustee Signed notice in a shorter period. The decision of Managing Trustee that a resolution has been carried or lost shall be conclusive, unless such a decision is challenged and a poll is demanded; on poll being demanded, the same shall be taken in such manner as the Managing Trustee may in discretion determine. In case of a tie the Managing Trustee shall have a second or casting vote.

- a) He shall be in charge of the office and shall be responsible to general body in all matters. He will contract in all ways and means of the position of the association and shall have right to improve it.
- b) He shall be convener of all the meetings and without his signature on the notice of meetings no meetings will be valid.
- c) It shall be his duty to see that the resolution at the respective meeting are implemented and give to effect to timely.
- d) He shall be at liberty to spend for the purpose of the trustee without sanction of the Managing Trustee to do all such other lawful notes, deeds of things as incidental or conductive to the attachment of trustee.

22. BANK OPERATION:

The bank accounts will be operated by the signature of the Mrs. Shobha Rai, Managing Trustee along with counter sign by either Mrs. Anjali Ghosh, Trustee or with the counter sign of Dr. Brahmeshwar Ray, Trustee.

23. DISSOLUTION OF TRUST:

In the event of dissolution of the Trust the properties and funds shall be transferred and paid to some other institution having similar objectives, which has been registered under section 12A of the Income Tax Act.

24. LEGAL JURISDICTION:

The cases pertaining to the Trust shall be filed and tried in the court/s in Patna only.
