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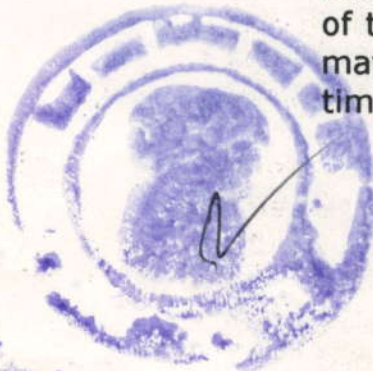

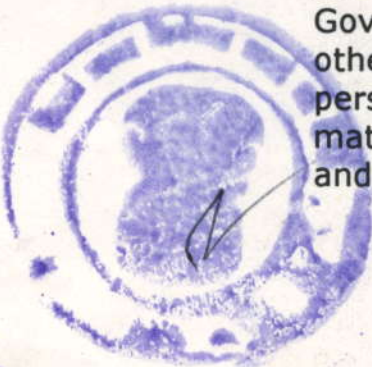

MANAGING TRUSTEE:

The Managing Trustee shall preside at all meetings of the trust, when he is present and shall exercise such other powers as are conferred upon him by these rules. 23. DISSOLUTION OF TRUST:

In the event of dissolution of the Trust the properties and funds shall be transferred and paid to some other institution having similar objectives, which has been registered under section 12A of the Income Tax Act.

24. LEGAL JURISDICTION:

The cases pertaining to the Trust shall be filed and tried in the court/s in Patna only.
